INDEPENDENT HOUSING

Independent housing is designed for seniors, generally those aged 55 and older. There are two types of Independent housing: market-rate and subsidized.

Market-Rate

Rents are set by the owner/operator based on local market conditions. Market-rate housing does not receive government funding to subsidize rents, and residents typically sign a lease that includes the monthly fee and services provided.

Some Market-Rate housing require an entrance fee that may be partially or fully refundable when the person leaves. Entrance fees, if applicable, are noted in this directory on a separate line as "Entrance Fees".



Questions to ask for Market-Rate Housing

- Is it located close to family, doctors, pharmacy, grocery, shopping, faith communities, and public transportation?
- What is the monthly rent and lease requirements?
- · How much is the security deposit?
- Are there entrance fees? If so, what is the cost and is the fee refundable?
- Are there additional charges for services or meals?
- Is there a Resident Service Advisor or Service Coordinator on site?
- Is there transportation services or do they coordinate transportation for residents?
- What type of floor plans are available?
 Can they be adapted as residents
 "age in place"?
- What are the security and safety features?
- What type of activities are offered?
- Are pets allowed?
- What is the smoking policy?
- Are garages available? If so, is there an additional cost?
- Is there a waiting list?

Subsidized Housing

Subsidized housing, also called "affordable housing," involves a government subsidy, which reduces the monthly rent for incomeligible seniors.

Senior Subsidized housing is restricted to persons over a specified age whose income is below certain levels.

Questions to ask for Subsidized Housing

- What are the income eligibility requirements?
- What is the monthly rent and lease requirements?
- · What is the security deposit?
- · Are there any additional costs?
- Is there a Resident Service Advisor or Service Coordinator on site?
- · What services are available on-site?
- Are transportation services available?
- Is there a waiting list?
- What are the security and safety features?
- Are pets allowed?
- What types of activities are offered?
- Is parking available?

Subsidized housing is regulated by HUD (www.hud.gov or 518-862-2801) or HCR (www.nyshcr.org or 518-473-2526). Additional information on HCR properties can be found at www.nyhousingsearch.gov.

ASSISTED LIVING/ADULT CARE FACILITIES

Assisted Living and Adult Care Facilities (ACFs) serve individuals who cannot or do not want to remain at home or in independent housing, and do not need continuous nursing care as would be provided in a nursing home.

There are several categories of **licensure** with Adult Care Facilities (ACF) and assisted living, and they often provide services. Some have additional licensure or certification to provided specialized services or to accept Medicaid. **Medicare does not cover payment for assisted living or adult care facility services.** All are licensed and overseen by the New York State Department of Health (DOH).

Adult Home (AH)

AHs provide room, board, housekeeping, personal care, and supervision to five or more adults.

Enriched Housing Program

EHPs provide room, board, housekeeping, personal care, and supervision to five or more adults over the age of 65.

Assisted Living Residences (ALR)

To be an ALR the facility needs to be

already licensed with DOH as an Adult Home or Enriched Housing Program. ALRs have a specific individualized plan for each resident. They provide information about services they offer and what these services cost. ALRs can be certified to provide special needs and/or enhanced services for additional fees or simply provide "basic" ALR services.

Special Needs Assisted Living Residences (SNALRs)

These SNALRs are licensed and approved by DOH to provide specialized services for people with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, or other cognitive impairments.

Enhanced Assisted Living Residences (EALRs)

With additional certification and approved by DOH, EALRs can provide or arrange for nursing care and other additional services in the facility as needed. These can include nursing services and therapy.

Assisted Living Program (ALP)

This program is the only assisted living option in the state that can accept Medicaid as payment. Be sure to check out the entire list of ALPs at the end of this directory.



Questions to ask for Assisted Living

- Is assisted living appropriate, based on the person's physical, financial, mental, and lifestyle needs? How is the need for services determined?
- Is there an "entrance" fee?
- What other services are included in the basic plan and what services are available for an additional cost?
- Each facility will require a recent medical evaluation from your health care provider. Ask the facility what is required for admission.
- Is there a waiting list?
- What is the dining environment like?
- What religious/spiritual programs are offered?
- There are several different types of assisted living. If you have specialized needs, ask how the facility will make sure your needs are addressed.
- Will this facility be able to meet your future needs?
- What happens if you do not have enough money for payment? Will you have to move to another facility?
- If you have long term care insurance, Medicaid, Supplemental Security Income and/or Veteran's benefits, does the facility accept them for payment?
- What sort of relationships does the facility have with nursing homes, hospitals, and home care agencies, should the resident need more or different care?
- Under what circumstances would a resident have to leave the facility?

FAMILY-TYPE HOMES FOR ADULTS

Family-Type Homes for Adults are private homes that provide an atmosphere of family living for adults who choose to live in a congregate setting. For more information on Family-Type Homes for Adults, go to:

NURSING HOMES

A nursing home, also known as a skilled nursing facility, provides 24-hour medical, nursing, and other services to persons of all ages with disabilities. These facilities are licensed by the New York State Department of Health.

Before being admitted into a nursing home, a screening process begins with a health care professional completing a Patient Review Instrument (PRI) to determine the level of care that is needed.



Questions to ask for Nursing Homes

- What are the findings from the most recent state survey, and is it available to review?
- Are amenities such as private rooms, cable service for individual televisions, and private telephones available? At what cost?
- What activity programs and special events are held at the facility or off-site?
- What religious/spiritual programs are offered?
- How many physicians are on staff? Do you have a choice between the facility's staff physician and your personal physician?
- Does the facility have staff providing occupational, physical, and speech therapy?
- Should hospitalization become necessary, which hospital does the facility typically use? What is the facility's policy on reserving your bed while you are in the hospital?
- Who coordinates admissions? Is there an orientation for new residents?
- Is there a resident and family council to provide input into the kinds of programs and problems the facility may have? How often do they meet?
- What may residents bring with them?
 Is there room for a favorite chair,
 photographs, and wall hangings?
- Is there a waiting list?
